Consequences

In the unlikely occasion that a student not follow the classroom guidelines, the consequences may include but are not limited to....

1. Verbal warning
2. Removal from activity or classroom
3. Phone call to parent or guardian
4. Removal from class to the Principal's office (Referral)

**Consequences may not happen in this order depending on the severity of the misbehavior.*

Grading

85% of the students' grade will consist of participation and behavior. The other 15% will include written tests, quizzes, article reviews, etc. The students will not be graded on physical abilities (but may be graded on **knowledge** of skill). Inappropriate attire and/or disruptive behavior can and will also result in losing some or all points for the day. For grading scale see Student Handbook.

Proper Attire

Students are required to come to class wearing proper attire. Proper attire includes clothes that they can move freely in and have no chance of exposure (some skirts, dresses, loose pants may be problematic). Proper attire also includes proper shoes. Any shoe with a **non-marking** sole, with a closed toe, and behind the heel support is acceptable. It is strongly recommended that all students keep shoes in their lockers. If you are unsure of what is appropriate see Mr. Morgan for help. Not wearing proper attire will result in loss of points for the day. Special consideration will be given on specific days (picture days, etc.)

Illness/Injuries

Any student that may be under the weather or injured **must have a parent note previous** to the day's activity to receive credit for the day. On the occasion that any extended illness or injury should occur, it is necessary that there be a doctor's note on file in the office.
