

## Joseph Arthur Middle School Player Expectations

Student-athletes are subject to school rules as well as team rules. In order to run a well disciplined, and organized team; players are held to certain expectations that other students may not be. Below is a list of rules and consequences to be followed by the student-athlete.

- ***Players are expected to be in attendance and on time for all games and practices.*** If there is a situation where a team function needs to be missed, the coach needs to be **informed in advance** in order for it to be excused. Unexcused absences include, but are not limited to, missing to serve a detention, forgetting equipment/clothing, not having a ride, grade ineligibility, etc.

- ***Players are expected to perform at team functions to the best of their ability at all times.*** Players are always expected to try their hardest at all times. HUSTLE is the key word.

- ***Players are expected to treat the coaching staff, teaching staff, and other players with respect.*** Players are always representing their team, whether they are on the field or not.
